We want to teach students their first instinct is to report to an adult. Students were given 5 scenarios to teach kids about crisis response and implement ALICE. Plans are in place for action based on location and type of threat. Scenarios that classrooms were given to debrief:

 Medical emergency 2. Rumor about gun at school 3. Custody threat and his dad is coming without permission 4. Evacuation 5. ALICE- Active shooter in the building

Students and staff discussed what to do if someone was trying to enter their classroom. Students discussed -barricades, distractions, running and where do we exit building and where to report after evacuation.
